Summer 2024 volunteer Internship Opportunities

RUN is seeking students to support its summer programme for refugee children aged 4 to 14 years old. Refugee children do not have the opportunity or the means to travel during summer break, and RUN aims to provide them with a fun summer experience in Hong Kong.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Accompany children to sport activities and support the coaches during sport;
- Develop and lead craft activities and games at the RUN centre;
- Assist RUN staff with the logistics for the organised activities;
- Provide feedback about the children to RUN staff;

Desired Skills & Qualifications:

- Good communication skills;
- Experience working with children preferred;
- Team-player and able to work with diverse groups of people.
- Emotional sensitivity to work with vulnerable children age 4-14 affected by poverty and trauma;
- Minimum age of 16 years old on July 1, 2024 (no exceptions);

Practical details

- SHINE activities will take place twice per week from mid July to mid August, and more specifically on Tuesday 16th July, Thursday 18th of July, Tuesday 23th of July, Thursday 25th of July, Tuesday 30th of July, Thursday August 1, Tuesday August 6, Thursday August 8, Tuesday August 13, Thursday August 15;
- Ability to attend and support during at least 3 out 5 weeks (6 days);
- Be present from 9.30am to 4.30 pm;
- Activities will start and finish at RUN's office in Wong Chuk Hang;
- Be able to attend a zoom or in person briefing early July (time TBC) and sign RUN's safeguarding policy (to be provided);
