We provide trauma intervention in a warm, friendly, and safe environment. RUN's programmes centre on three goals: **R**ebuild the mental and physical strength of refugees, **U**nite them as a community and **N**urture them into a more hopeful future through life skills and education.

The Position:

RUN is seeking a patient and dedicated English Teacher to lead our English Programme. Founded in 2015, RUN is embarking on a new phase of strengthening and growing our programmes, including offering education to all participants. The ideal candidate has excellent interpersonal skills, experience working with disadvantaged students from diverse backgrounds, and is passionate about education. This role is perfect for teachers who want to leave a lasting impact on the lives of Hong Kong's most vulnerable refugees and asylum seekers.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Lead and design curriculum for Beginner and Intermediate/Advanced English classes and IELTS exam preparation
- Develop assessments to place students in appropriate classes and track progress
- Create organized and engaging lesson plans for each class
- Supervise and instruct students during class time
- Provide individual support to students needing additional instruction
- Communicate regularly with RUN management on student needs and progress

- Good class management skills
- Cultural awareness and an ability to communicate with people from cultures different than their own
- Exercises discretion and able to maintain confidentiality
- Honest, strong work ethic and committed to integrity
- Patient, friendly, positive, excellent interpersonal skills and passionate about education
- Love of the English language; excellent grasp of English grammar and writing skills
- Diploma or above qualifications in English, English Literature, Education or other related disciplines
- Possess teaching qualifications, or holding a TESL, TEFL, TESOL or equivalent

- Must have right to work in Hong Kong
